


#### BRAIN SCIENCE MEETS STORY-TELLING

- Five Times Exposure Theory:
   Seeing words in different contexts
   locks them into long-term memory
- Hebb's Rule: Neurons that fire together wire together--repetition strengthens brain pathways
- Spaced Repetition: Encountering words across time beats cramming every time.

- Emotional Context = Deeper Learning:
   Decision-driven stories create stronger
   memory anchors
- Pairing academic words with slang creates instant bridges between familiar and unfamiliar language





#### WHY SLANG SUPERCHARGES TEEN BRAINS

#### FAMILIAR LANGUAGE + BIG WORDS = UNFORGETTABLE LEARNING

Adolescents learn through pattern recognition--they absorb meaning by noticing how words + phrases repeat across different settings (think text messages, mems, video games etc.)

Pairing unfamiliar academic words with familiar slang taps into that same system, creating mental "shortcuts" for understanding + memory

The emotional tone of slang makes vocabulary stick--humor, surprise + relevance all boost attention and recall

When slang explains a word's meaning, it reduces the mental effort student need to decode it in context.


The result? Students encounter words repeatedly, in playful settings--turning exposure into real retention


